
WHISTI FR

DAY I CALGARY

OCT 01 04 08

Pick up your rental car and spend time exploring Calgary. Included is admission to the Calgary Tower. Overnight in Calgary.

DAY 2 CALGARY TO LAKE LOUISE

Drive from Calgary through beautiful Kananaskis country and the ranching regions of Alberta before arriving in Lake Louise. Enjoy an afternoon lakeshore stroll around Lake Louise, or for the more adventurous, a hike up to Lake Agnes Tea House (1–2 hours one way). Overnight in Lake Louise.

DAY 3 LAKE LOUISE TO KANANASKIS

Enjoy a leisurely drive along the Bow Valley Parkway for views of Castle Mountain and Johnston Canyon (requires a short walk). On your way to Kananaskis, stop off in Banff to enjoy such sights as Bow Falls, Lake Minnewanka, Surprise Corner, and the Hoodoos. Overnight in Kananaskis.

DAY 4 KANANASKIS

Today, enjoy one of Alberta's biggest recreational playgrounds. There are plenty of paved pathways for easy hiking, or rugged trails for the more adventurous. Cycle through evergreen valleys, past glacial streams on many kilometres of paved trails. For the avid fisherman, hike into the high alpine lake or just cast off the shores of the Kananaskis lakes. Play the 36-hole golf course, or take a trail ride by horse through the Kananaskis Valley, ending with the thrill of whitewater rafting on the Kananaskis River. Overnight in Kananaskis.



Your journey starts gently, moving through the fertile farmland of the Fraser Valley and the rolling hills of the Coast Mountains. As your train gains altitude beyond the town of Hope, the Fraser River narrows and the waters run rampant. The train will slow to fully appreciate Hell's Gate, a narrow canyon where the volume of water rushing through is about three times greater than Niagara Falls. At the midway point of your journey, near your overnight stop in Kamloops, the river valley remains lush and green while sagebrush covers the surrounding desert-like hills.



When you board the train after spending the night in a charming Kamloops hotel, you will follow the North Thompson River, slowing to take in Pyramid Falls, a 91.5 metre (300 ft.) cascade of whitewater. After giving you time to pick up your jaw, the train continues on to the Yellowhead Pass. Moving past teal-green lakes, you'll close in on Mount Robson, the tallest peak in the Canadian Rockies. It's so high it has its own weather system. The striking thing about this route is that once you've seen what you think is the most beautiful sight ever, something even more stunning comes along. To cap it all off, you'll wind up in the alluring alpine town of Jasper.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

1. DOES ROCKY MOUNTAINEER HAVE SLEEPER CARS?

The train does not have sleeper cars. You spend your days on the train and your nights in comfortable hotel accommodation. This way, you will not miss a moment of the stunning scenery along your journey.

2. CAN CHILDREN TRAVEL ON ROCKY MOUNTAINEER?

Yes, unless otherwise noted. However, the Rocky Mountaineer journey through the Rockies is a minimum of two nine-hour days onboard the train, which may be long for some children, and is not recommended for infants.

3. HOW FAR DO I TRAVEL ON ROCKY MOUNTAINEER

In Kamloops and Quesnel, guests will overnight in moderate accommodation with essential amenities. We are unable to offer hotel upgrades for the overnight stops in Kamloops, Quesnel, or Whistler.

9. WHAT MEALS DO I RECEIVE?

Meals that are included as a part of your itinerary will be noted with either (B) (Breakfast), (L) (Lunch), (D) (Dinner) on each package page. When you are not onboard the train, you may be able to add meal options to ensure breakfasts and dinners are pre-arranged for part, or all, of your itinerary please contact your vacation consultant. 1. Passports & Visas

Passports: If travelling from outside Canada (including from the USA) you will require a passport for entry into Canada and appropriate identification (ID) for all family members. All guests travelling on our Coastal Passage route will require a valid passport and/or visa (depending on their citizenship). Rocky Mountaineer, along with airlines and cruise ships reserve the right to refuse boarding without adequate ID.

Visas: Check with your travel professional, Immigration Canada, or United States Customs and Border Protection. Rocky Mountaineer is not responsible for guests refused entry into Canada or the United States because of inadequate documentation. For further information regarding entry requirements into Canada please contact Immigration Canada. Single parents or grandparents travelling with children must ensure proper documentation is obtained for entry into Canada.


