### When to Go

Spring (March to May) and autumn (September to November) are the two most comfortable seasons in which to visit Japan, when there is little rainfall, skies are clear and temperatures are mild. The best time to see cherry blossoms in most of the major cities is early April, however, they can bloom as early as January on the islands of Okinawa and as late as May on the northern island of Hokkaido. The rainy season is generally from the end of May to mid July and the humidity is high through summer. Come autumn, leaves turn red and gold and Japan is ablaze with colour. The winter months (December to February) are very cold and excellent conditions for skiing and other winter pursuits.

### **Visas & Passports**

A valid passport is required with at least six months validity beyond the intended stay. Travel advice is available from the New Zealand Government Ministry of Foreign Affairs and Trade at safetravel.govt.nz.

### Time

Japan is three hours behind New Zealand Standard Time (NZST). Daylight Saving Time is observed from October to April where their clocks are turned forward by one hour.

### Currency

The YEN (JPY) is the official unit of currency in Japan. While credit cards are slowly being accepted, cash is recommended while travelling in Japan. International ATMs are widely accessible in post offices and convenience stores 24 hours a day.

### **Tipping & Bargaining**

Tipping is not required and any tips left will be given back to you. It is also considered rude to bargain in Japan.

### Language

Japanese is the official language and English is not widely spoken.

### Electricity

Eastern Japan 100V 50Hz. Western Japan including Nagoya, Kyoto and Osaka 100V 60Hz. An adapter is required.

### Etiquette

Japan has a culture steeped in tradition. Manners are very important amongst the Japanese and you should be aware of basic rules. In Japan, people greet each other by bowing – shaking hands is uncommon. It is rude to talk loudly, eat or drink while walking, talk on your phone while on a train or place feet on seats. Always use an umbrella when it rains, place money on the tray when making purchases in a shop and stand to the left on escalators. There are strict rules relating to footwear – shoes should be removed in traditional ryokan, some restaurants, temples, castles and other historic buildings.

### **Getting Around**

Travelling in Japan is easy. For travel between regional cities and towns, purchase a Japan Rail (JR) Pass and use the Shinkansen (bullet train). The JR Pass can also be used for the metro in most major cities. Alternatively, an IC Card can be purchased and topped up as necessary for travel within Tokyo, Osaka and Kyoto.

### **Rail Passes**

Japan is a country of contrasts. From glorious ancient temples, to the hustle and bustle of Tokyo's Ginza district, traditional rural villages to cool mountain regions, a Japan Rail Pass can take you to all of these destinations.

If your plans are to fully explore a single region of Japan then an area pass may be your best option. There are passes which cover Osaka, Kyoto and the surrounding region.

### Japan Rail Pass

A Japan Rail Pass covers all of Japan's main islands and is valid on all Shinkansen (bullet trains) except Nozomi, as well as express, rapid and local trains, JR bus companies and the JR Miyajima ferry. Purchase a pass for 7, 14 or 21 consecutive days of unlimited travel.

There are two classes of travel to choose from – an Ordinary Pass offers standard class travel and a Green Pass provides a superior level of comfort, comparable to 1st Class services. A Japan Rail Pass is simply the most convenient way to explore Japan.



### JR Hokkaido Pass

Hokkaido is known for its Ski areas, volcanoes and natural hot springs. Explore this northern island with the JR Hokkaido Pass which allows unlimited travel on all JR Hokkaido lines of Hokkaido Railway Co. and selected bus lines of JR Hokkaido Bus. A flexible 4 travel days in 10 days option is also available.

### JR West Kansai Area Pass

With a Kansai Area Pass you are free to explore the many sights of the Kansai region. If you are planning to visit Osaka, Kyoto, Nara and Himeji or some of the cities in between, then this is the pass for you. The pass is valid for unlimited travel on any standard trains and non-reserved seats on Haruka within the Kansai area.

### JR West Kansai Wide Area Pass

The Kansai Wide Area Pass provides unlimited access to JR trains in the Kansai region, Okayama and neighbouring towns in the Chugoku region. From Osaka or Kyoto you can explore the entire region, from the Sea of Japan to the Pacific Ocean.

### 1. Our Services and Obligations

- 4.2 While we have exercised reasonable care and skill to ensure that the contents of this brochure are correct, accurate, and up-to-date at the time of publishing, please note that the contents of this brochure are based on information supplied to us by the Suppliers. We do not have, and cannot be reasonably expected to have, personal knowledge about all the facilities or services provided by each Supplier.
- 4.3 Facilities or services may change after the date of publication. We endeavour to keep travel agents informed of any changes to information in this brochure that are brought to our attention. Prior to booking your ticket, you should ask your travel agent about any changes to the published information of which your agent may be aware. You should also make sure that if your travel agent is advised of changes that occur after booking, your travel agent is able to contact you.
- 4.4 All maps, illustrations and photographs are for indicative purposes only and may not necessarily reflect actual places or positioning.

#### 5. Prices

- 6.4 Credit Card not permitted unless travel agent acts as merchant.

#### 7. Amendment or Cancellation

- 7.1 If you wish, or circumstances require you to amend or cancel your booking for any reason, you should advise us in writing through your travel agent at the earliest possible time.
- 7.2 Where you cancel any booking more than thirty (30) days prior to your departure you are likely to have to pay a fee. A cancellation fee of \$200 will be imposed where cancellation is made within thirty (30) days prior to your departure, plus any suppliers charges as per note 7.3. Please refer however to Clause 7.6 for special conditions in some cases.
- 7.3 The above cancellation fees are required to offset booking, communication and administration charges that will have already been incurred by us.
